 - **Canned Tuna, Salmon, Turkey, Ham**
 - **Canned Tomatoes**
 - **Canned Fruit or individual Fruit packs**
 - **Canned Peas and Canned Mixed Vegetables**
 - **Cooking Oil**
 - **Butter or Margarine**
 - **Peanut Butter**
 - **Healthy Children's Snack packages**
 - **Toothpaste, Toothbrushes, and Feminine Hygiene Products**

As mentioned before, the office is open between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., so these items can be dropped off. I will also be in most days if you want to touch base (of course I am always available by email or phone).
