Just a short note to remind people that if you are planning to come to the **Wednesday Eucharist tomorrow in the Church at 10:30 a.m.** then you need to do the following:

- 1) Note that the service does not start until 10:30 in the morning.
- 2) Enter only by the Richmond Road doors in to the Main Church (not the Chapel) at 10:20 - no earlier please!
- 3) You will need to register at the door: name, phone number, and email address.
- 4) You will be shown to a seat where you remain for the full service -- unfortunately there is no mixing and mingling.
- 5) Communion will be brought to you and you must use the Rubbing Alcohol spray before and after receiving.
- 6) There is no singing or music at the service.
- 7) When the service ends you exit through the Richmond Road doors without congregating together. There is no refreshment hour.

I hope that is all clear -- basically it is the same as on Sunday mornings right now. This will be a service that remembers St. Simon and St. Jude but also uses the bulletin from last Sunday. I look forward to seeing those who are able to join us.
