Today is also the day that we commemorate **John Chrysostom**, an ancient bishop of Constantinople whose eloquence earned him the nickname, "John the golden mouth." But he was more than a brilliant preacher. He also led a life of true holiness, giving himself continually both to prayer and to the cause of justice. He died in 407 CE. Here is the prayer for today then:

***O God, you gave a golden eloquence to your servant John that he might declare your justice before the face of the proud and mighty. Grant us, after his example, such faithfulness to your word, that we may strengthen the hearts of the weary and sustain those who are afflicted by wrong; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen***
