

Update from All Saints' Email to the Parish from The Venerable Christopher Dunn 18 July 2021

I know that some of you stuck with it this morning on the Zoom worship link. I am sorry to say that while I thought we had everything resolved and working alright, the obvious problem did not start until I was at the altar and leading worship (not at the audio desk monitoring the Zoom feed).
