Today we send our best wishes to all those “south of the border” who are celebrating the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. We pray for you and for all our neighbours.

This morning, we celebrated the **Fifth Sunday after Pentecost**. Today, we heard the gospel story of Jesus’ return home to Nazareth and the reception that he received. During the announcement time at the end of the service, you will hear the instructions about the move to Amber in the Diocese starting on Tuesday. This means that next Sunday, we will welcome those who wish to attend in-person for the first time since Christmas (see the following note about registration through the website). I mentioned registration for **next Sunday's Eucharist** at 9:30 am. You will find the link to the Registration app on our Parish website at <https://www.allsaintswestboro.com/register-for-sunday-service/>. The registration does have a cut-off based on the number provided by the province. You can register starting tomorrow (Monday) morning at 9:00 am; registration will close on Friday at 12:00 noon. You will receive a confirmation email, which is automatically generated by the system, when you register; and, you will receive another email on Friday afternoon confirming your attendance and the protocols to be followed in keeping with COVID restrictions. The best way to register is by filling out the online form; however, if you do register by calling the church office, please make sure to leave a voicemail indicating you’d like to register, as well as the day and time of your call.

So this week, you can join us for the **Wednesday Eucharist**, in the Church, at 10:30 am. Please do not arrive earlier than 10:20, so that you can be registered at the door and seated. Masks are required at all times, and there is no social hour.
