This Sunday, at 3:00 pm, the 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Lecture Series of the Diocese of Ottawa will continue with The Rev. Dr. Sam Wells presenting a lecture and discussion on **Re-Imagining Church**. Sam Wells is one of today's most influential public theologians. He writes, speaks, preaches, and broadcasts on a range of pastoral, political, and theological issues. Sam has been Vicar of St Martin-in-the-Fields in Trafalgar Square, London, since 2012. He is also Visiting Professor of Christian Ethics at King's College London. He has served as a parish priest for 23 years—10 of those in urban priority areas; he also spent seven years in North Carolina, where he was Dean of Duke University Chapel. He has published 40 books.
